Software News : AmigaSYS 4 - WinUAE version released!

It is a bit late, but finally the new AmigaSYS has arrived. Perhaps this version took the most time, but it was not for nothing. Anybody that has used the older AmigaSYS systems before will see huge differences. The new AmigaDOS 3.0/3.1/3.9 installers are finished with 3-4 times more knowledge and with support for five languages. Both new and old users will experience a lot of new and interesting things in AmigaSYS 4. Almost every install is supported, and maybe the possibility of installing AmigaOS 3.9 without needing to have 3.0/3.1 will attract more people to try it...
